

## **FULL DAY DELHI TOUR (0930 hrs to 1700 hrs)**

New Delhi was designed and built by the British in the 1920's - it's a city of wide boulevards, impressive Government buildings, green parks and gardens. You will visit two monuments - **Humayun's Tomb** and **Qutab Minar**. Your drive takes you along the **Ceremonial Avenue** and **RAJPATH**.



Later you will see **Red Fort**, the most opulent Fort and Palace of the Mughal Empire; **Rajghat**, the memorial site of Mahatma Gandhi; and **Jama Masjid**, the largest mosque in India.

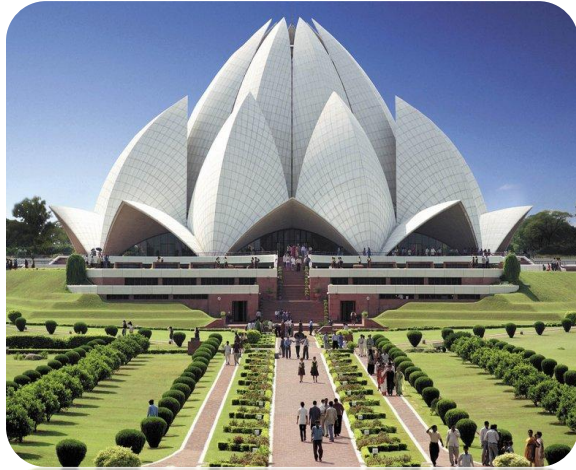

Later you will visit **Akshardham**. Akshardham means the eternal, divine abode of the supreme God, the abode of eternal values and virtues. Akshar is defined in the Vedas and Upanishads as the place where divine bhakti, purity and peace forever prevails.

For the first time ever in the world, witness the heritage of India in all its facets, insights and beauty at the Swaminarayan Akshardham through its mandir, exhibitions, verdant gardens and other attractions.

## LIVING SYMBOL OF LOVE - THE TAJ MAHAL

### Delhi – Agra – Delhi (Day Return Tour on road)

Early morning drive to Agra. Agra is situated on the banks of river Yamuna. It achieved prominence as the capital of the Mughal Emperors from 1526 to 1628. It remains a major tourist destination because of its many splendid Mughal-era monuments, most notably the Taj Mahal, Agra Fort and Fatehpur Sikri, all three are **UNESCO World Heritage sites**.



On arrival you will visit **Taj Mahal**, symbol of eternal love, which stands on the banks of River Yamuna. It was built by the 5th Mughal emperor, Shah Jehan in the year 1631 in memory of his wife, Mumtaz Mahal. It was completed in 22 years.

Afternoon halt for lunch at good restaurant.

Further you visit **Agra Fort**, taken over from the Lodhis by the Mughal Emperor Akbar in the late 16th century. The Fort can be more accurately described as a walled palatial city. It was built from red sandstone, often inlaid with white marble and intricate decorations.



At last, before driving back to Delhi you will visit to **Fatehpur Sikri** and en-route visit **Sikandra**, a magnificent garden tomb of the Mughal Emperor Akbar. Fatehpur Sikri was built by great Mughal ruler Akbar as his capital. Here you will see amazing **Bulund Darwaza** - the largest gateway in the world, and the **Tomb of Sheikh Salim Chisti**, a famous Sufi saint of India of that time.

Later you will be driven back to Delhi and on arrival in Delhi, you will be dropped at your respective places of stay.

## PINK CITY TOUR

### Delhi – Jaipur – Delhi (Day Return Tour on road)



Early morning drive to **Jaipur**, popularly known as **Pink City**, the flamboyant and colorful capital of Rajasthan. With its rich and colorful past, resplendent with tales of valour and bravery, it is now one of the most important heritage cities in India. The city was founded in the year 1728 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, the ruler of Amber. It remains the only city in the world symbolizing the nine divisions of the universe, through nine rectangular sectors.

On arrival, first you will visit **Amber Fort**; the palace complex which stands to this date was commenced under the reign of Raja Man Singh.



Next you will visit the **City Palace**, a perfect blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. The center of the palace is a seven-storied building called Chandra Palace, with fine views over the gardens and the city. Further you visit **Jantar Mantar** (Solar Observatory), an astronomical treasure house, with solar devices that give accurate predictions till date. You now visit **Hawa Mahal** (Palace of Winds), a five-storied structure of pink sandstone. It was built in the year 1799 so that veiled royal women could peer down the busy street market unseen by the world through its 593 stone Jharokas (mini windows).

Later you will be drive back to Delhi, and on arrival in Delhi you will be dropped at respective places of stay.

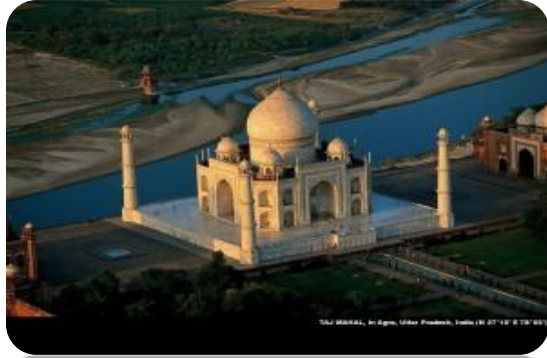

#### **Day 01: Delhi to Agra (220 kms-4 hours) (Half Day Tour)**

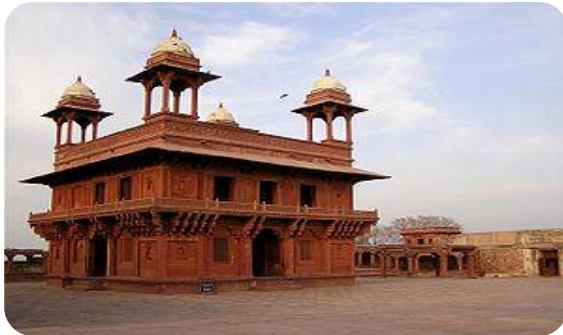

You visit **Emperor Akbar's Residential complex, Mosque and Tomb of Salim Chisti**.

Further you continue our drive to **Jaipur**, the flamboyant and colorful capital of Rajasthan. With its rich and colorful past, resplendent with tales of valor and bravery, it is now one of the most important heritage cities in India. The city was founded in the year 1728 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, the ruler of Amber. It remains the only city in the world symbolizing the nine divisions of the universe, through nine rectangular sectors. Your personal guide will take you to these immaculate places.

Later in the evening, you can have your own choice. *Our guide will give you a clear picture of Jaipur markets.*

#### **Optional Tour - Chokhi Dhani:**

An evening excursion to Chokhi Dhani complex, ethnic village resort located at a distance of 15 km from Jaipur. Rajasthani village atmosphere is recreated on the sprawling ground and includes the entertainment by folk dancers and musicians. Later drive back to hotel.
